RULES

USGA Rules effective January 2021 govern all play with these local rules

FORMAT OF PLAY: 54 Hole Stroke Play

Players will be grouped into six flights by handicap. After 36 holes the Championship flight will be cut to top 70 players and ties.

TEES: Championship flight plays blue tees All other flights play white tees

TIE BREAKER:

Ties for first place in each flight will play off starting on hole 6.

MARKED BALL DROP LOCATIONS (NO PENALTY)

#5 –Behind green for balls coming to rest on practice green or paved area around club
#9 – Behind green for ball coming to rest in the parking lot or drainage area left of green
#9 – Next to fenced electric area for interference by the fence under rule 16
#18 - Behind green for balls within pool fence.

OUT OF BOUNDS:

Tee shot from 10 coming to rest in 18 fairway is OB. Tee shot from 18 coming to rest in 1 fairway is OB. Boundary fence right of holes 3 thru 8. Course edge of paved road right of holes 9 and 10.

LOCAL RULES

- Vehicles parked on the course are temporary immovable obstructions. MLR F-23 may be used for relief for stance, lie, swing, and line of sight.
- If a ball strikes a power line during play of holes 3 or 4, the stroke is cancelled and the next stroke is played from the same place.
- MLR E-5 shall provide an alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or ball Out of Bounds. Ball may be dropped no closer to pin with 2 stroke penalty.
- · No practice is allowed on the last green played.
- When uncertain about rules, player may play two balls under rule 20.1c(3).
- The course contains both bunkers and waste areas. Bunkers are prepared sand areas adjacent to greens or along fairways on holes 1, 5, 8, 10, 11 and 18.
- A Code of Conduct under rule 1.2 is posted in the clubhouse. For safety reasons, hitting tee shots on hole 10 over the pool is prohibited and will result in a two stroke penalty. The Committee may impose a penalty of disqualification for deliberately hitting a tee shot over the swimming pool.
- The pool behind the green on hole 18 is considered to be an immovable obstruction. A drop area is available for free relief for balls inside the pool fence. For balls outside the pool fence, relief is allowed under rule 16.
- When taking back on a line relief, MLR E-12 shall allow for balls to be played even though the ball rolls out of a relief area, so long as the ball does not roll more than a club length and does not end up closer to the hole than the original location of the ball.
- PACE OF PLAY: Under MLR K-2, a group which falls more than a hole behind may be notified by the Committee that they are out of position.
- Exception 2 to Rule 11.1b applies, except that when a ball played from the *putting green* accidentally hits: the player, the club used by the player to make the *stroke*, or an *animal* defined as a *loose impediment* (that is, worms, insects and similar *animals* that can be removed easily) the *stroke* counts and the ball must be played as it lies.
- · No relief from dirt cart paths. Paved paths one club length
